## **Volunteering in PEI equivalent of 4,000 jobs: New study** *Devote more time to health charities than residents of other provinces*

**Toronto, December 11, 2003.** More than one-third of Prince Edward Island residents volunteer time to a charity or nonprofit organization, according to a new study by the Canadian Centre for Philanthropy. Island residents volunteered 7.4 million hours in 2000, the equivalent of almost 4,000 full time jobs.

The findings come from the latest analysis of data gathered in 2000 in the National Survey of Giving, Volunteering and Participating. The study also found that Island residents devoted more of their volunteer hours to health organizations than did volunteers in any other province.

“This analysis is the first time we’ve been able to take such a detailed look at how people in each province support one another in their communities,” said Dr. Michael Hall, president and CEO (interim) of the Canadian Centre for Philanthropy. “These results are particularly relevant at this time of year when people are more aware of the importance of the work of charities and voluntary organizations.”

The National Survey of Giving, Volunteering and Participating is a partnership between the Canadian Centre for Philanthropy and the federal Department of Canadian Heritage, Health Canada, Human Resources Development Canada, Statistics Canada and Volunteer Canada. In 2000, the survey gathered a substantial amount of information from more than 15,000 individual interviews. Researchers have been looking at various aspects of the data ever since to better understand how Canadians give to charity and participate in their communities.

The Canadian Centre for Philanthropy is a national, charitable organization that works to advance the role and interests of the charitable sector for the benefit of Canadian communities.
