NONPROFIT AND CHARITABLE SECTOR

- Reform of non-qualified donee requirements
- Investments in data collection and information sharing
- Sustained funding for COVID-19 response and recovery efforts
- A home in government for the nonprofit sector
- Investment in nonprofit childcare
- Support for BIPOC communities
- Investment in digital transformation and innovation
- Funding for the transition to net-zero

ARTS AND CULTURE

- Reforms to the Copyright Act
- Funding and support for the arts and culture sector, especially workers

SOCIAL FINANCE

- Implementation of a Social Innovation and Social Finance Strategy
- Development of tools and resources to support entrepreneurs, especially women and BIPOC communities

INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Funding for an international assistance envelope

ENVIRONMENT

- Funding for conservation and biodiversity
- Implementation of climate mitigation and adaptation solutions
- Support for workers and communities in the natural resource sector

HEALTH

- Funding for healthcare, mental health and research
- Implementation of a national universal pharmacare program
- Investments in long-term care

SOCIAL SERVICES

- Funding to support BIPOC communities
- Development of training and employment programs, especially for youth
- Development of a federal affordable housing plan
- Collection of disaggregated race-based data

EDUCATION AND RESEARCH

- Investment in Canadian research and innovation, especially climate research
- Funding for the development of clean technologies
- Funding for employment training and education programs
